Today's show and sale of 2500 Mule Ewe Lambs was kindly sponsored by Paul Chuter ATV and ably judged by Mr Andrew Geary and Mr Henry Hutchinson with Mr Edwin Holliday acting as referee. A super show of lambs met a better than expected trade throughout the sale with trade showing improvement over earlier sales. Topping today's sale was the overall Champion pen from Messrs J Lee & Sons, Morley Hill which having strong interest eventually sold to Mr Haig Murray for £280.

The judges had a hard task of selecting their winners from the 10 pens forward in the show.

The show results are as follows:

Strong tuppings lambs didn't see much difference on the year with 365 of the lambs selling between £95 and £280. The greater proportion were running lambs and these selling nicely with the trade between £70 and £86 producing an overall sale average of £79.37.
