The catalogued entry of 16 vendors saw stronger tuppings types forward, with all lambs very keenly bid for, vendors leaving highly delighted. Comparing to last year's excellent trade for small running lambs, this year they met with more buyers resistance but still sold well.

The ring side of buyers year on year is getting larger with more sheep required for next year's sale already.
