A good show of Calves and Stirks forward today, the younger calves looking particularly well, with their coats shining and good skins to match.

Topping at £790 a cracking pair of 7-month-old British Blue Steer Stirks from GN Hetherington, Crookdake House, who also consigned the top priced Heifer, another 7-month-old Blue, selling to £670, allowing them to take the top average of the Day at £750 for three animals sold.

Top Bull Stirk accolade at £730, was taken by a 10-month-old British Blue Bull Stirk from NJ & JM Todhunter, Greyrigg House, who also consigned another 9-month-old British Blue Bull to £725, taking their average to £573.33. Weaned Stirks topped at £470 for a 10-week-old British Blue Steers from Tarnrigg Ltd, Tarnrigg Moor, whilst the younger milk calves topped at £385 for a cracking 6-week-old British Blue Heifer Calf from Messrs Watson, Syke House.
