CALVES & STIRKS – 69

A nice show of Calves and Stirks forward today, with a good mix of all ages and types forward, trade holding firm on the fortnight, especially for the younger weaned stirks and calves age group.

Topping today at £785 a 10-month-old British Blue Bull Stirk from K Brough & Son, Bolton Cottage Farm, who also took the top Heifer accolade for a 9-month-old Beef Shorthorn Heifer Stirk, selling to £730, taking their average to top the day at £757.50 for two animals sold.

Milk Calves topped at £475 for a 10-week-old Charolais Bull from Messrs WJ Wannop, Waverton House, who also sold Charolais Heifers to £430, taking this run of 7, 10-week-old calves to average a very respectable £416.43. Topping the Heifers, an 11-week-old British Blue, selling to £460, taking Tarnriggs run of 5 calves to average £440.00.
